

THE VERBS DRINK AND EAT

TO EAT

To eat, share a meal – Wepumauonat
He ate (with them) – Wehpumop
You will eat with me – Pish Koowepimimwoo
They will eat with me – Yeush who Noowepemukquog
He is eating – Metzuz
He eats (food) – meech
I eat meat – Numeech weyaus
They are eating - Meetsuog
He eats (an animate object) – Moowhau
He eats too much – Wussaumepoo
He feasts – Mishadtuppoo
He eats with others – Weetadtuppoo
He has finished eating – Mahchippoo

TO DRINK

To drink – Wuttattamunat
I drink – Nootatam
He drinks – Wuttattam
Drink (imper.) – Wuttattash
They drank – Wuttattamwog
A drink – Wuttattamoonk
My drink – Nootattamoonk
His drink - Ootattamoonk
To drink too much – Wussaumsippaminneat
Don't be drunk – Ahque Kogkesupamwish
